Scholarship Committee: The Club provided for the restoration of the 1877 Charles H. Hitchcock "Geology Map of New Hampshire" - The map has been picked up from the conservator in Cambridge, M. Photographed and delivered to the Museum of the White Mountains in Plymouth, NH. The Map should be mounted and framed to complete the final restoration process. Gordon Jackson proposed the following: To authorize the Club to spend up to \$2000.00 for the mounting and framing of the 1877 C.H. Hitchcock "Map". This will allow the Museum to proceed with the final phase. The Funds of the Club will not be significantly affected. The Museum has no moneys for this type of restoration. The By-Laws require a two vote process so the same article must be warned and voted upon again at the January Meeting. This will complete the process for permanent display of the map. Currently on loan from UNH. The Club will be recognized for its restoration efforts.
