
The auctions will pretty much end John's collection. But as always we saved the best for last. So there should be something for everyone.

We need to have a short business meeting at the beginning of the live auction to vote on two grant proposals.

- 1. To provide \$1500.00 to acquire the book "The Geology of New Hampshire's White Mountains" to be provided to New Hampshire High School libraries with and appropriate cover letter and book label From the Capital Mineral Club, Concord, NH in the memory of John W. McCrory Jr. This was voted in the affirmative at our last meeting. Our By-Laws require a warning before a final vote so last meeting was the warning.
- 2. To provide \$3000.00 for the preservation of the original map "Geological Map of New Hampshire, Vermont and Western Maine by Charles H. Hitchcock 1877-1878". This is the first full geology map of New Hampshire and is beautifully hand colored. The map has never been conserved and is in need of major restoration. After conservation/ stabilization the map is to be displayed at the Museum of the White Mountains in Plymouth, NH. Should we provide funds we will be appropriately mentioned with the map display.

The Board recommends the above and with your approval we will be able to move forward.

This will be a rain or shine event. So come, bid, vote, eat, socialize and brag about where your going digging this summer - if it will ever stop raining.
