Trip to Yale Peabody Museum of Natural History

Martin Kippley made a presentation of his findings regarding the trip to Yale as follows:

Entry fees to the museum are \$13 for adults, \$9 for 65+, and \$6 for children 3-8

The membership chose to go with Concord Bus with a 51 passenger bus leaving from Concord terminal for \$2000 instead of Premier Coach with a 36 passenger bus for \$2100

The museum has handicap access but no dining facilities. There are several places nearby to eat.

Martin Kippley will reserve the bus for Saturday, September 21st, 2019 and request a tour of the mineral museum.

It was suggested that the deadline to sign up would be the last day of July 2019.

A request was made to see if the bus could stop in Nashua to pick up members that live further south. Kip will look into the possibility with Concord Coach and advise the membership. A sign-up sheet was started at the May meeting.

Additional discussion was made to offer the trip to other clubs if we are unable to fill all the seats on the bus or to offer a trip as a prize at the show.

An email will be sent to the membership with additional details including what portion the club will pay, how much each member would contribute, and when the non-refundable deposit would be due, etc.
